The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, seeking a writ in the nature of *Certiorari* for setting aside the impugned order dated 08.08.2023 (Annexure P-6) passed by the learned Deputy Commissioner, Fatehgarh Sahib and also the order dated 27.03.2024 (Annexure P-8) passed by the learned Divisional Commissioner, Patiala Division, Patiala, under the provisions of Punjab Allotment of State Government Land Act, 2016 (for short, 'the Act of 2016').
