SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. Since the learned Addl. Advocate General, Haryana submits, at the bar, on instruction imparted to him, that both the impugned Annexures i.e. P-10 & P-14, have been challenged at the instance of the aggrieved concerned, through a revision petition becoming filed before the Financial Commissioner concerned. Therefore, till the validity of the said impugned Annexures, is settled through a decision becoming made by the Financial Commissioner concerned, as such, till the stage(supra), this Court does not deem it fit, and, appropriate to make any adjudication in respect of the validity of the impugned Annexures (supra).

2. Consequently, the writ petition is misconstituted and/or is premature, and, as such, the same is hereby dismissed at this stage. However, liberty is reserved to the petitioner, to in case he becomes aggrieved, from any adversarial decision made against him by the Financial Commissioner Haryana, upon the apposite revision petition, to thus, make a challenge thereto through

3. Since the present petitioner is likely to be evicted from the disputed lands, thereupon, liberty is reserved to the present petitioner, to within a week from today, seek stayings of operation of the orders directing the petitioner to vacate the disputed lands, through an application being preferred before the Financial Commissioner concerned. On such an application being preferred, the Financial Commissioner, Haryana, shall pass a lawful order thereons, within a period of one week from the date of preferment of the said application. However, till the preferment of the said application before the Financial Commissioner concerned, the parties are directed to maintain *status quo* over the land in dispute, as it exists today.
