1 By way of present petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.2 to 4.

2 The grievance of the petitioner is that she is being called to the police station time and again without following procedure as laid down under the Code on the basis of the complaint moved by respondent No.5.

3 Short reply by way of affidavit of Narinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Shahkot, District Jalandhar (Rural) on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4 has been filed. The same is taken on record. The precise stand taken by the State reads as under :-

“6. That the representations submitted by the petitioner having No. 3955-PTM dated 18.10.2023 and 4001-PTM dated 23.10.2023 also need no action to be taken as they have been declared innocent in the inquiries conducted by Deputy Superintendent of Police, Special Crime, Jalandhar (Rural) and Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Nakodar, Jalandhar (Rural) as the allegations leveled by Respondent No. 5 against the petitioner are false and baseless.

7. That it is submitted that it has been verified that the petitioner has not been harassed at any point of time. In case she was called by the police then it was only in regard to the above said inquiries and no other reason. That since the said inquiries have been concluded therefore, the petitioner has not been called again and further direction has been given to the concerned Station House Officer that the petitioner should not be called until unless there is a valid legal reason to do so in accordance with law and the same will be done after serving her summons under the provisions of Cr.P.C.”

- 4The aforesaid statement satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner.
- 5In view of above, no further order is warranted.
- 6Disposed off accordingly.
