Learned counsel for respondent No. 1, on instructions from
Ms. Rajnesh Kaur, Deputy Director (Field), Food & Supplies Department,
submits that the petitioner shall be allotted paddy for KMS 2024-25, subject
to furnishing the security of two millers who have been allotted paddy by the
State of Punjab, within a period of one week from today.

[2] In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does
not press the present petition any further.

[3] Dismissed as not pressed.

[4] However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-
stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek

revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring / concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
