The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya
Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking quashing of FIR No.3 dated
23.02.2024 under Sections 406/498-A/420 of IPC and Section 12(1)(b) of
Passport Act, 1967 registered at Police Station NRI, District Sangrur and all
subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioners *inter alia* contends that this is a matrimonial dispute and the son of the petitioners and respondent No.2 after their marriage could not adjust with each other and due to temperamental differences, they parted their ways since February, 2018. The dispute involved in the present petition is purely private in nature and the petitioners have been falsely implicated reason being the parents of the husband of respondent No.2. He further submits that he would be satisfied in case all the documents which are annexed with the present petition are considered by the Investigating Officer before submitting a final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.

Notice of motion.

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On receipt of advance notice, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab puts in appearance and submits that he has no objection in case, the Investigating Officer is directed to consider all the documents which are annexed with the present petition before preparing a final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.

The matter is taken up for final disposal with the consent of the parties. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Investigating Officer to consider all the documents which are annexed with the present petition before preparing a final report under Section 173 of Cr.P.C.

It is clarified that in case a final report under Section 173 of Cr.P.C. is against the petitioners, the petitioners would be at liberty to file a fresh petition to challenge the FIR as well as the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.
