KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(Oral)

1. Through the instant petition filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS), prayer is made for grant of 'anticipatory bail' to the petitioner in case FIR no.123, dated 25.09.2024 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 118(1), 115(2), 351(2), 3(5) of the BNS, 2023, (Section 118(2) of BNS, 2023, added later on), registered at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar Rural.

2. After arguing for some time, when this court was not inclined to grant the asked for relief to the present petitioner, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition, however, with liberty to the the petitioner to surrender

before the learned trial court concerned, and upon doing so, his regular bail application, may be directed to be decided in a time bound manner.

3. As prayed, instant petition stands **dismissed as withdraw**. However, considering the second prayer as, made by learned counsel for the petitioner, being innocuous and *bona fide*, therefore, this Court directs the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court concerned, within 10 days from today, and upon doing so, if the petitioner moves a regular bail application, the latter shall make all its endeavours to decide the same within 02 days thereafter, on its own merits, in accordance with law, after giving adequate opportunity of hearing to the parties concerned, including complainant.

4. All pending application(s), if any, also stand **disposed** of accordingly.
