1. The petitioner prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent no.2 to re-issue passport to him after changing his date of birth from 07.02.1967 to 09.04.1968.

2. The learned counsel representing the respondents submits that the petitioner's file has been closed because he failed to respond within the prescribed time. However, she submits that if the petitioner applies afresh along with the relevant documents, the same shall be considered by the competent authority in accordance with law laid down in **Resham Singh vs. Union of India and another, 2008(1) R.C.R. (Civil) 131.**

3. The learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that the petitioner will file a fresh application.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the writ petition is disposed of.



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5. However, the fresh application submitted by the petitioner shall be disposed of by the competent authority within a period of one month from the date of filing of the application.

6. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
