The present petition has been filed by the petitioner for grant of
compassionate appointment after the death of her husband late Gagandeep

Singh. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the private respondent i.e. family members of Gagandeep Singh were opposing the grant of the benefit of compassionate appointment to the petitioner by making certain allegations but now, the matter has been compromised between the family and the petitioner and a written compromise deed has been entered on 26.08.2024 and as per the said compromise, the family has no objection in case the claim of the petitioner is considered for the grant of compassionate appointment. Learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions of their respondent clients who are present in Court submits that the terms and conditions as mentioned in the said agreement between the parties dated 26.08.2024 will be honoured by both i.e. the petitioner as well as the family of Gagandeep Singh.

From the compromise deed dated 26.08.2024, it is clear that the family of the deceased husband of the petitioner has no objection in case, the claim of the petitioner is considered by the Department for compassionate appointment as admissible to the petitioner being a widow of the serving employee being in service, who died in harness.

Learned State counsel submits that as, now there is no objection being raised against the petitioner to be treated as widow of the serving employee namely Gagandeep Singh, who dies while in service, for consideration for grant of compassionate appointment, the said claim of the petitioner will be considered in accordance with the law for compassionate appointment and appropriate order on the said consideration will be passed within a period of 8 weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the respondents submit that in case, it is found that the petitioner is eligible for the grant of compassionate

appointment after the death of her husband namely Gagandeep Singh, who was a serving Class-1 Officer, appropriate relief will be given by passing a speaking order within a time frame. In case, the petitioner is not found entitled for the said relief, the due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order for her information and necessary action.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.

Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
