KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(ORAL)

1. Through the instant petition, as instituted under Section 482 of the B.N.S.S., the petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail, in case FIR No.0137 dated 26.11.2023, under Sections 379B(2) and 34 of the IPC, 1860, and under Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Majitha Road, District Amritsar.
2. After addressing arguments for some time, when this Court was not inclined to grant the asked for relief, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the instant petition, however, with liberty to the petitioner, to surrender before the learned trial Court concerned, and further made a prayer that the bail application, if preferred by the petitioner before the latter, same may be decided most expeditiously.
3. Leave granted.
4. Consequently, the instant petition is **dismissed as withdrawn,**

however, with liberty to the petitioner, to surrender within 10 days from today,

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before the learned trial Court concerned, and thereupon, if he makes an application before the latter for grant of bail, the latter shall decide the same within two days, but, after affording adequate opportunity of hearing to the parties concerned.

5. **Disposed of** accordingly.
