SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. The present petition has been filed as Public Interest Litigation (PIL) by the petitioner, who is a resident of Aman Village, near Sham Palace, Patiala Road, Rajpura, District Patiala, and is aggrieved by air pollution and other nuisance caused by usage of open land next to his residential colony being used for stacking harvested paddy.
2. On asking the respondents as to whether the said area has been declared as seasonal market yard or not, it was informed in negative.
3. However, learned counsel for Punjab Mandi Board (respondent No.3) as well as learned State counsel assure that the said area shall be cleared



latest by 10.11.2024, so that whatsoever nuisance or inconvenience caused to residents of the colony is eliminated.

4. With the said assurance given by learned counsel for respondent No.3 – Punjab Mandi Board as well as State of Punjab, this petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to re-visit the Court, in case his grievance remains unredressed.
