HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Mr. Avinash Yadav, Executive Engineer, OP Division DHBVN, Charkhi Dadri, submits that the order passed by the Writ Court shall be complied with within a period of 07 days from today, subject to outcome of an intra-court appeal.
2. In view of the aforesaid undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the present petition.
3. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed being not pressed. Rule stands discharged.

However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
