1. Through the instant petition, prayer is made for grant of interim bail for 03 months in case FIR No.180, dated 07.07.2024, registered under Section 21 of the the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985, at Police Station Sahnewal, District Ludhiana, on medical grounds.
2. A perusal of the instant petition reflects that, in fact the instant petition is a misconceived motion, inasmuch as, despite the petitioner being seized of an alternate and efficacious statutory remedy for redressal of her grievance before the learned trial court concerned, yet she has sidetracked the said remedy and have straightway accessed this Court, through instituting the present petition.

3. Therefore, the petitioner is relegated to the learned trial court concerned, to claim the relief, as has been sought through the instant petition.

4. In case such application is filed by the petitioner, the learned trial court concerned is directed to decided the same within 02 days from the date of filing such application, in accordance with law, after hearing the concerned parties.
