In the present petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioners is that the petitioners have been given the additional charge of the post of Superintendent Grade-II which shows that the work of the said post needs to be discharged by duly promoting the employees to the said post on regular basis but, in order to avoid the payment of the salary, the petitioners are being made to discharge to duties of the higher posts in their own pay scale rather than considering their claim for regular promotion against the post of Superintendent Grade-II, which is arbitrary and illegal.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners have already filed number of representations claiming regular promotion against the said post against which the petitioners are discharging their duties and one such representation dated 14.03.2024, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-14 has been attached and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to

decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.Amarpreet Singh Bains, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the representation dated 14.03.2024 (Annexure P14) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioners, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioners in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be duly conveyed to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.

Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
