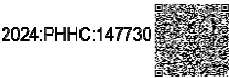

NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for quashing the order dated 20.09.2024 (Annexure P-5) issued by respondent No.2 intending to make/effect recovery of Rs.5,22,264/- from the pensionary benefits of the petitioner after her retirement from service on 29.02.2020; to release the revised pensionary benefits payable to the petitioner on account of revision of pension and other retiral benefits as per recommendations of 6th Punjab Pay Commission in view of notification dated 29.10.2021 (Annexure P-1) along with interest @ 12% per annum and for restraining the respondents from making/effecting any recovery from the petitioner on the basis of impugned order dated 20.09.2024 (Annexure P-5), during the pendency of the present writ petition.



2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during the pendency of the present petition, order of recovery dated 07.11.2024 has been passed. He wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file present petition impugning the order dated 07.11.2024 on the same cause of action.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
