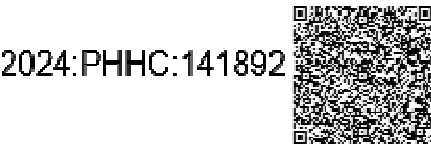

This petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 has been filed for issuance directions to the respondents to take appropriate decision and complete the investigation in case FIR No.117 dated 30.03.2024, registered under Section 406 & 420 IPC, at Police Station Pundi, District Kaithal and further seeking direction to the official respondent(s) to take action on his representation dated 19.08.2024 (Annexure P2).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has filed a representation dated 19.08.2024 (Annexure P2) before respondent No.3 raising his grievances as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereupon. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if, appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.3, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereupon.

3. Notice of motion.



4. At the asking of the Court, Mr. Anmol Malik, DAG, Haryana with Mr. Deepak Thukral, Addl. AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent(s)-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paper-book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 19.08.2024 (Annexure P2) of the petitioner expeditiously, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.

6. Needless to say, if any threat is found to the petitioner, the official respondents would provide them adequate security in order to protect their life and liberty.

Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
