Counsel for the petitioners submits that the present petition has been filed by run-away couple who performed marriage on 18.10.2024 against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 7, who are extending threats to cause harm to the petitioners and in this regard, representation dated 17.10.2024 (Annexure P-5) is already submitted by the petitioners to respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Amit Kumar Goyal, A.P.P., U.T., Chandigarh accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and submits that as per the statement of brother of petitioner No.2 which is recorded by the police, now there is no apprehension of threat to the petitioners from the side of private respondents. The copy of the same is taken on record.

4. Counsel for the petitioners submits that even now the petitioners are facing threats from the side of private respondents.
5. In light of the above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh to consider representation dated 17.10.2024 (Annexure P-5) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order..
6. However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the marriage of the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.
