1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of order dated 13.10.2022 (Annexure P-1) in FIR No.318 under Section 21(b) (later on added Section 27-A, 31 of NDPS Act), Police Station City Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

2. In the present case, petitioner jumped bail on 13.10.2022 and consequently, his bail/surety bonds were cancelled and he was directed to be summoned through nonailable warrants of arrest vide order (Annexure P-1). Being aggrieved, the petitioner has filed the present petition.

3. On the last date of hearing, the petitioner was granted interim bail with direction to join the proceedings before the trial Court subject to deposit of cost of Rs.10,000/- with the District Legal Services Authority,

Fatehabad.

4. Today, counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the aforesaid order, petitioner deposited the cost and also joined proceedings before the learned trial Court and is presently on interim bail and counsel for the petitioner produced copy of the concerned order dated 23.12.2022 in this regard whereby presence of the petitioner is marked by the learned trial Court.
5. The status report by way of an affidavit of Jaipal Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Head Quarter, Fatehabad filed on behalf of the State is taken on record.
6. Counsel appearing on behalf of the State has not refuted the assertions made by counsel for the petitioner and further submits that the present petition be disposed of accordingly.
7. In light of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 16.12.2022 is made absolute. The petitioner should regularly appear before the trial Court on each and every date of hearing fixed in the trial.
