1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in a case FIR No.191 dated 21.09.2023, registered under Sections 15 and 21 of NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Sidhwan Bet, District Ludhiana.

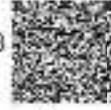
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition qua petitioner No.2- Dharminder Singh and submits that the present petition would survive qua petitioner No.1- Sukhdev Singh @ Babbu only.

3. In view of his request, the present petition qua petitioner No.2 Dharminder Singh stands dismissed as withdrawn.

4. By virtue of order dated 07.12.2023, while granting interim protection, petitioner- Sukhdev Singh @ Babbu was directed to join the investigation.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that petitioner- Sukhdev Singh @ Babbu has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

6. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Lakhwinder



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Singh, has affirmed the fact that petitioner- Sukhdev Singh @ Babbu has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation. He further submits that challan has also been presented.

7. In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 07.12.2023 qua petitioner No.1- Sukhdev Singh @ Babbu is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
