On 21.12.2022 the following order was passed:-

“ *The Counsel for the petitioner shall apprise this Court as to how the order dated 07.04.2022 (Annexure P-8) passed by JMIC, Zira can be set aside in view of the fact that the sister of the petitioner herself has consented to acceptance of the cancellation report with a prayer that she wishes to file a complaint in the court.*

On 27.04.2023 the following order was passed:-

“ *On request of the learned Proxy Counsel for the petitioner adjourned to 11.10.2023.”*

Thereafter on 11.10.2023 the following order was passed:-

“ *On request, adjourned to 01.05.2024.
In the meantime, the complainant is at liberty to file a private complaint in accordance with law.”*

It appears that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing her petition.

In view of the above, the present petition is hereby dismissed for want of prosecution.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to get it revived if any cause of action still subsists.
