1. Present revision petition has been preferred against the impugned order dated 03.01.2024 passed by learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Samalkha, Panipat, vide which, in the proceedings initiated under Section 125 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (*now Section 144 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023*), interim maintenance of Rs.8,000/- per month was awarded to be paid to the respondents i.e. *Rs.6,000/- per month to respondent No.1 and Rs.2,000/- per month to respondent No.2.*
2. The case has been called twice since morning and despite that there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. It appears that neither the petitioner nor his counsel is interested in pursuing the present revision petition.

3. In view of the above, having left with no other option, present revision petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
4. All the pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
