SUMEET GOEL, J. (Oral)

1. The substantive prayer made in the petition reads thus:

“It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that a direction may kindly be issued to the Ld. Trial Court to decide and conclude the Trial of the FIR No.10, dated 04.0.2020 under Section 498-A, 406, 323 and 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered in Police Station P.S. Women, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar (Annexure P-3), the challan (Annexure P-4) in a time bound manner as the Fir was registered on 04.03.2020, Challan was presented on 08.10.2020 and the Chief of the Respondent No.2 complainant was recorded on 10.06.2022 and thereafter till date the respondent no.2 have not appeared for cross examination and is trying to delay the matter just to harass the old parents in law, in the interest of justice.”

2. Keeping in view the nature of the prayer made in the petition in hand, this Court does not deem it appropriate to call upon the respondents at this stage.

3. Having heard the learned counsel for the parties; upon perusal of the record and keeping in view the entirety of facts and circumstances of the case, especially the factum of the FIR in question having been registered on 04.03.2020, the trial Court is directed to make an earnest endeavour to

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decide the main trial at an early date preferably within eight months from the date of receipt/production of certified copy of this order.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
