1. Ms. Manpreet, Advocate appeared and entered into appearance on behalf of legal heirs of respondent No.2 by filing Vakalatnama. The same is taken on record.

2. On 08.11.2023, following order was passed:-

“Compromise-cum-Full and Final Settlement dated 03.11.2023 is placed on record as Annexure P-3 to contend that complainant has accepted to settle the dispute for a total sum of Rs.13,50,000/- i.e. a cheque amount and out of that Rs.12 lakhs stands paid by the petitioner to the complainant as mentioned in the settlement and remain amount of Rs.1,50,000/- shall be paid by the petitioner to the complainant within 2 months from the date of settlement i.e. 03.11.2023 as per the covenant contained in the settlement itself.

*On asking of the Court, Mr. Gaurav Bansal,
D.A.G., Haryana appears and accepts notice on behalf of*

respondent No.1/State. Adjourned to 29.02.2024.

In the meantime, the sentence of the petitioner shall remain suspended.”

3. Today, counsel appearing for the petitioner has produced receipt as well as copy of the demand drafts to submit that complete payment of the settled amount has been made. The aforesaid fact is admitted by the counsel for respondent No.2.

4. This Court is satisfied that the complainant has agreed to compound the offence of the petitioner. Resultantly, the present petition is disposed off in lieu thereof.

5. Pending applications, if any, shall stand disposed off.
