JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.143 dated 27.03.2023 registered under Sections 406 and 420 IPC and Section 24 of Immigration Act (Section 370 IPC added later on) at Police Station Naraingarh, District Ambala.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 29.02.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 29.02.2024 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and she shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
