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JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J. (ORAL)

On 15.11.2023, the following order was passed:-

*“The prayer in this petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for setting-aside of the order dated 23.08.2023 (Annexure P-3) passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana whereby bail of the petitioner has been cancelled and his bail and surety bonds have been forfeited to the State in case FIR No. 276 dated 07.12.2017 registered under Sections 365/386/506/379-B/120-B IPC read with Section 25/27 of the Arms Act at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana, Ludhiana Police Commissionarate.*

*The Counsel for the petitioner contends that on account of miscommunication between the petitioner and his counsel, the petitioner was unable to appear on 23.08.2023, because of which the impugned order came to be passed. He states that he is ready and willing to join the proceedings once again.*

*Notice of motion for 11.01.2024.*

*In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a period of one week from today and subject to a deposit of Rs.25,000/- as costs with the Shree Shiv Kanwar Mahasangh*

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*Charitable Trust (Regd.), # 36A, Near Gugga Marhi  
Mandhir, Maheshpur, Sector 21, Panchkula, Haryana  
Account No.55020100001119, IFSC  
BARBOMDCPAN(0-ZERO) Bank of Baroda, Swastik  
Vihar, Panchkula, he shall be admitted to interim bail  
to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.*

*The petitioner is further directed to place on  
record the photocopy of receipt of payment as well as  
the order passed by the court below granting interim  
bail to the petitioner.”*

Thereafter, on 16.12.2023, the following order was passed:-

*“The present application has been filed by the  
applicant/petitioner for extension of time to appear and  
deposit fine in compliance of the order dated  
15.11.2023 passed by this Court.*

*Heard.*

*For the reasons mentioned in the application, the  
same is allowed and one week more time is granted to  
the applicant/petitioner to comply with the order dated  
15.11.2023 passed by this Court.”*

Though the petitioner has deposited a sum of Rs.25,000/-  
but he has not complied with the aforementioned orders of this Court for  
surrendering and seeking the concession of interim bail.

In view of the above, I find no merit in the present petition.  
Therefore, the same stands dismissed.
