MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.07 dated 11.01.2022, under Sections 302 & 201 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Kunjpura, District Karnal.

(2) This Court, on 18.12.2023, granted interim bail to petitioner and the order reads as under:-

“Learned State Counsel on instructions submits that during investigation, petitioner was found innocent and his custodial interrogation is not required at this stage; however, he seeks more time to have instructions in the matter.

Posted for 26.02.2024.

Petitioner shall surrender before learned trial Court within a period of two weeks from today and upon doing so, he be released on interim bail, in the present case, till the next date of

hearing on furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.”

- (3) Learned counsel submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has already joined the proceedings before learned trial Court and he shall fully cooperate in future.
- (4) Learned State Counsel, on instructions, acknowledged that petitioner has joined the proceedings and as on today, his custody is not required.
- (5) In view of above, interim order dated 18.12.2023 is made absolute as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.
- (6) It is made clear that the petitioner shall fully co-operate with the learned trial Court and shall not seek unnecessary adjournments.
- (7) The above observations may not be construed as an expression of opinion on merits of the case; rather confined only to decide the present bail matter.
- (8) Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
