1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 18.11.2022 passed in CWP-35887-2019.
2. Short reply by way of affidavit of R.S.Dhillon, Director General Elementary Education, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Navneet Gupta, Principal Accountant General (A & E), Haryana, filed in the Registry, is take on record.
4. While referring to the aforesaid short reply and compliance report, learned counsel for the respondents have submitted that GPF

Account No.HREDU/164603 has already been allotted to the petitioner by treating him as covered under the Old Pension Scheme. Therefore, the order dated 18.11.2022 passed in CWP-35887-2019 has already been complied with.

6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
