1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case having FIR No.185 dated 06.07.2023 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 279, 323, 336, 506 and 307 of IPC(Section 307 of IPC was added later on) registered at Police Station Nangal Chaudhri, District Mohindergarh.
2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case by his own wife namely Pooja. That petitioner was granted interim bail by this Court vide order dated 09.11.2023 with direction to join the investigation and in compliance of the said order, the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police.
3. Status report by way of an affidavit of Jitender Kumar, HPS,

Deputy Superintendent of Police, Narnaul, District Mahendergarh filed on behalf of the State is taken on record.

4. The State counsel on instructions from ASI Gautam submits that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and further the petitioner is not required by the police for any further investigation or custodial interrogation and the recovery of vehicle in question is already effected.

5. In light of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 09.11.2023 is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions as provided in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
