SUVIR SEHGAL, J.(ORAL)

1. Instant revision petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a direction to the Court of learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, SAS Nagar, Mohali (Executing Court) to decide the execution preferred by the petitioner, bearing Exe. No.401-2020 titled as Hament Gupta Vs. Subhash Gupta, within a fixed time period.
2. Pursuant to the order passed by this Court, report has been received from the learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, SAS Nagar, Mohali, which is taken on record.
3. At this stage, counsel representing the respondents has appeared and apprised the Court that the respondents have filed objections under

Section 34 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, to Arbitral Award, alongwith an application for condonation of delay. He submits that a notice has been issued by the Court to the respondents in January, 2024. He has placed on record a copy of the objection petition as well as the interim order passed by the Court of learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, Mohali.

4. In view of the above development, the prayer made in the petition cannot be entertained at this stage.

5. Petition is dismissed.
