The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 seeking direction to official respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct fair inquiry into the matter and to decide and take action on the representation dated 17.07.2024 (Annexure P-2).

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Jaspal Singh Guru, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and informs the Court that representation dated 17.07.2024 (Annexure P-2) has been addressed to Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga who does not have the jurisdiction to adjudicate on the issue and accordingly after examination, the same has been further forwarded for adjudication to the Commissionerate Jalandhar in whose jurisdiction the respondent No.4 is residing and the demand of money as alleged paid at Jalandhar.

In the light of above, learned State counsel undertakes to facilitate further adjudication of the said representation from the competent authority, to whom the matter has now been forwarded being the appropriate authority, within a period of four weeks from today by passing a speaking order in accordance with law. The order so passed in the said representation shall be communicated to the petitioner within a period of one week thereafter.
