The appellant has filed an appeal under Section 14-A of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities), Act, 1989 (for short 'SC/ST' Act) challenging the order dated 18.04.2024 passed by the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Panipat in case arising out of FIR No.212 dated 20.06.2021 registered under Sections 323, 328, 376 (2) (n), 376-D, 506 of IPC and Section 3 of SC/ST Act, at Police Station Israna, District Panipat.

Prayer in the application (CRM-43371-2024) has been made for condoning the delay of 98 days in filing the appeal.

I have heard learned counsel for the appellant and have gone through the record.

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It is revealed from the record that the applicant had previously filed Criminal Appeal bearing No.CRA-S-1833-2024 titled as '*Anil Vs. State of Haryana and another*' before this Court thereby challenging the same order dated 18.04.2024 which has been challenged now. The said appeal had been dismissed by this Court, vide order dated 17.05.2024. Since, the order dated 18.04.2024 has already been challenged by filing aforementioned appeal which stands dismissed, therefore, this appeal cannot be stated to be maintainable by any stretch of imagination. The applicant has also not been able to give any satisfactory reason for condonation of delay in filing this appeal. As such, the application does not deserve to be allowed and the appeal is also liable to be dismissed on the ground of maintainability.

Dismissed accordingly.
