AMARJOT BHATTI, J (Oral):

1. Petitioners have filed the present petition under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India for directing official respondents No.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6. Since, the petitioner No.1 was minor she was sent to Nari Niketan, Sector-26, Chandigarh, till further orders vide order dated 28.10.2024. She was ordered to be produced in the Court from the said Nari Niketan, vide order dated 22.11.2024. Today, both petitioners are present in the Court along with their counsels. Respondent No.6 namely Vinod Kumar and his wife respondent No.7 namely Shobhawati, both parents of petitioner No.1 are present in the Court. Umawati-petitioner No.1 is ready to accompany her parents. Ms. Aakanksha, Advocate filed Vakalatnama on behalf of petitioner No.2. The parents of the girl petitioner No.1 confirmed that the matter has been compromised.



Since the matter is settled between the parties. Therefore, petitioner No.1 Umawati minor be handed over to her parents i.e. Vinod Kumar (father) and Shobhawati (mother) by the said Nari Niketan, Sector-26, Chandigarh, as per rules. In view of compromise, no further direction is required and the present petition stands disposed of having rendered infructuous.

2. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
