KARAMJIT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* submits that petitioner who is a senior citizen is being unnecessarily harassed by the police officials of Police Station Nihal Singh Wala, District Moga. The police officials are time and again visiting the house of the petitioner at odd hours, in search of his grandson Harjot Singh. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that said Harjot Singh is already disowned by petitioner and the local police is also fully aware about this fact. That petitioner has given representation dated 01.10.2024 (Annexure P-3) with request to respondent No.3 that police officials should not unnecessarily harass the petitioner. However, the police authorities failed to take any action on the basis of said representation. Being aggrieved, petitioner has filed the present petition seeking necessary direction to respondent No.3.



2. Notice of motion.
3. Mr. Jasjeet Singh Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and on instructions from ASI Jagdev Singh submits that Harjot Singh grandson of the petitioner is a hardened criminal and is required by the Moga police in 7 criminal cases. It is further submitted that house of the petitioner was raided only to arrest his grandson. Otherwise, the police officials have never harassed the petitioner in any manner. Further, in case any such representation given by the petitioner is pending, the same will be looked into and decided by the competent authority in accordance with law, at the earliest.
4. In light of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of with direction to respondent No.3 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga to consider and decide representation dated 01.10.2024 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner, as per law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
