Prayer in this writ petition filed by the petitioners under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of ceritiorari, for quashing the action of the respondent – State, Government of Punjab, whereby the petitioners were not granted the benefit of pension. Further a writ of mandamus has been sought for directing the respondents to release the pension and other retiral benefits to the petitioners under the Pension Scheme and under the Punjab Civil Service (Premature Retirement) Rules, 1975, for taking into account their appointment in the District Rural Development Agencies, in terms of the ratio of law laid down by the Hon’ble Supreme Court of India in various judgments.

After arguing the matter for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file afresh petition, on the same cause of action, with better particulars.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
