The present appeal has been filed against the order dated 30.11.2022 whereby Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar has dismissed the anticipatory bail filed by the petitioner in case of FIR No. 133 dated 07.08.2021 under Section 447 and 448 IPC and Section 3(1)(g), 3(2) (Va) of SC and ST Act, 1989 (offences under Section 3(1)(g), 3(2)(Va) of SC and ST Act, 1989 added later on) at P.S. City Nakodar, District Jalandhar (Rural).

Learned State Counsel submits that the Presiding Officer, National Lok Adalat, Nakodar has acquitted the appellant wherein by compounding the offences in light of the compromise effected between the parties vide order dated 09.12.2023.

In light of the above, nothing survives in the present appeal.
