1. Learned counsel for the respondents while relying upon a communication dated 16.12.2024, submits that the interest on the delayed disbursal of leave encashment shall be released to the petitioner in terms of the order passed by the Writ Court within a period of two months from today.
2. In view thereof, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the present petition.
3. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed being not pressed. Rule stands discharged.

However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
