1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 2(b) read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 21.08.2023 passed in CWP-19861-2022.
2. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 21.08.2023 passed in CWP-19861-2022 has since been complied with and necessary order has been passed. It is further submitted that vide receipt dated 22.05.2024, costs of Rs.10,000/-, as imposed upon the respondent, have also been deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Bar Clerks Association, Chandigarh. The said receipt produced by the counsel for the respondent in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
