1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to her in case FIR No.148, dated 16.05.2023, under Sections 21(b), 25,29 of NDPS Act and under Sections 21(c), 22, 27A of NDPS Act and Section 25 of Arms Act added later on, registered at Police Station Division B, District Amritsar, Punjab.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 28.10.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
