1. While issuing notice of motion on 14.11.2023, following order was passed:-

“Counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* submits that the petitioner already stood admitted to bail and there was no reason for him to evade presence and was appearing on each and every date. However, on the fateful day i.e. 03.06.2023, he could not appear as he was under wrong impression that FIR Nos.77 and 78, registered under NDPS Act are being tried together.

Notice of motion, returnable for **04.03.2024**.

Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

The petitioner undertakes to appear before the trial Court on the next date of hearing there on 17.11.2023.

Subject to appearance of the petitioner before the trial Court on 17.11.2023, the operation of the impugned order dated 03.06.2023 (Annexure P-3) shall remain stayed.”

2. Today, counsel for the petitioner has produced order dated 20.11.2023 passed by Special Court, Jalandhar to demonstrate that he appeared before the trial Court in terms of the directions issued and now stands admitted to bail.
3. In view of above, no further order is warranted.
4. Petition stands disposed off.
