1. *Vakalatnama* filed on behalf of the respondent No.3 is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the respondent on instructions from SI Yadwinder Singh informs that the benefits towards family pension which are payable to the petitioner in terms of order dated 04.04.2024 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa shall be released to her within a period of one week from today.
3. In view of the aforesaid undertaking by learned counsel for the respondents, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.

towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing
of revival application.
