1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.195 dated 29.09.2023, registered under Sections 304, 404, 34, 201 of IPC, at Police Station City-I, Abohar, District Fazilka.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 07.12.2023 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Mohan Lal, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 20.12.2023 and is no longer required for further investigation.
4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 07.12.2023, passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
