1. The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to allow the petitioner to join his duty as Data Entry Operator in pursuance of the approval granted by respondent No.2 on 26.09.2023 (Annexure P-1) which is evident from letter No.27 dated 09.04.2024 (Annexure P-2) as he was working from 18.07.2008 for more than 15 years and to grant him all the consequential benefits along with interest @ 6% per annum from the date when the approval was granted by respondent No.2 on 26.09.2023 for allowing him to join his duty.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner had served a legal notice dated 23.08.2024 (Annexure P-10) to the respondents but the same has not been considered and decided till date. He further submitted that at this stage, he will be satisfied in case the aforesaid legal notice dated



23.08.2024 (Annexure P-10) is considered and decided by the respondents in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Rajni Gupta, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents. She submitted that in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, she has no objection in case time bound direction is issued in this regard.
5. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, without calling for reply from the respondents and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4/competent authority to consider and decide the legal notice dated 23.08.2024 (Annexure P-10) strictly in accordance with law and within a period of three months from today.
