The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.217 dated 29.09.2023, registered under Sections 420, 120-B of IPC, at Police Station P.S.Division No.8, District Jalandhar.

Vide order dated 22.11.2023, both the parties were directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

Today, learned counsel for the parties have submitted that with the intervention of the Mediator, the compromise deed/settlement dated 30.11.2023 has been signed by both the parties. Learned counsel, on instructions from their respective clients, submit that the parties shall remain bound by the terms in the compromise.

In view of this statement, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 22.11.2023, passed by this Court, is made absolute. In case, the petitioner does not comply with the terms of the compromise, the necessary consequences would follow, in accordance with law.
