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DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (Oral)

1. The present intra court appeal arises out of judgment dated 07.07.2023 passed by a learned Single Judge of this Court disposing of the appellant's writ petition.
2. A perusal of the impugned judgment reveals that the only prayer made on behalf of the appellant before the learned Single Judge was for the issuance of a direction to the Municipal Council, Maur (for short, the MC) to conduct demarcation of land bearing Khasra No.1//12/2 situated in village Maur Khurd, Tehsil Maur, District Bathinda.
3. On the statement made before the learned Single Judge by the counsel for the MC that the counsel would get the aforesaid land demarcated from the revenue authorities, the appellant's petition was disposed of.
4. The prayer made on behalf of the appellant was conceded to by learned counsel for the MC and on the basis thereof the appellant's petition was disposed of by the learned Single Judge. Therefore, there is no cause left with the appellant to knock the doors of this Court through the instant appeal.
5. Dismissed.
6. Pending Miscellaneous application(s), if any also stand disposed of.
