1. Present revision petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 151 CPC for initiating appropriate criminal proceedings under Section 340 of Cr.PC against the respondent/wife.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that earlier CRM-M-15892-2018 titled as “Narinder Bhutani vs. Anjali Bhutani” was filed by the petitioner and vide order dated 22.08.2024, the said petition was withdrawn in view of the judgment passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court in **CRM-M-19553-2023** titled as “**Jaspal Kaur alias Pinki and others vs. State of Punjab and others**” decided on 24.04.2023. It is submitted that as per the judgment dated 25.10.2024 of the Division

Bench of this Court passed in *CR no.3407 of 2024* titled as “*Hemant Bhagat and others vs. Prekshi Sood Bhagat and other connected matters*” the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been held to be maintainable. It is submitted that in view of the bar under the Cr.P.C., the order dated 22.08.2024 passed in CRM-M-15892-2018 cannot be recalled and thus, the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

3. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
