1. The petitioner prays for grant of interim bail in order to attend the marriage functions of his son. He is in custody in FIR No.15, dated 06.12.2017, registered under Section 21 and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (hereinafter referred to as the '1985 Act') (lateron added Section 18 and 25 of the 1985 Act), at Police Station S.T.F., Phase-4, Mohali. The marriage functions are stated to be at Amritsar and Ambala, respectively.

2. The learned counsel representing the State of Punjab, on instructions from ASI Dashmesh Singh, STF, Mohali, has submitted that he does not dispute the aforesaid factual position.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the State of Punjab is directed to make arrangements for the petitioner to attend the marriage functions of his son on 27.10.2024 at Amritsar and on 29.10.2024 at Ambala, while being in custody. It shall be the responsibility of the State to prevent any escape.

4. Petition stands disposed of.
5. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also
disposed of.
