The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.132 dated 27.09.2023 registered under Sections 324, 341, 148, 149 and 120-B IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) registered at P.S. Division No.2, Pathankot.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 14.11.2023 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel has filed short reply by way of affidavit dated 29.01.2024 of Mr. Sumeer Singh, PPS, DSP, Sub Division City, District Pathankot in Court today, which is taken on record and on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 14.11.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 14.11.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
