1. Through the instant second petition, filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C., a prayer is made for grant of relief of regular bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.49, dated 29.05.2023 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 21(C)/29/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, and under Sections 10, 11 and 12 of Aircraft Act, 1934, registered at Police Station Khalra, District Tarn Taran, Punjab.

2. Custody Certificate dated 05.11.2024, qua the petitioner, furnished by learned State counsel today, in the Court. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof, supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. There is no supervening or changed circumstances in the instant matter, after the first regular bail application, having been dismissed as withdrawn, vide order dated 29.07.2024 (Annexure-P-4), and without waiting further for the progress of the trial, the instant petition has been filed, within a

period of three months approximately. Therefore, this Court is not inclined to consider the case of the present petitioner, to grant the asked for relief (supra).
