NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. Present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ of *mandamus*, directing the respondents to count the past service of the petitioner rendered on daily wage basis from 02.02.1990 to 01.10.2003 as his qualified regular service for the purpose of pensionary benefits and other consequential monetary benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the said purpose petitioner has also served a legal notice dated 22.04.2024 (Annexure P-3), however, same has not been replied to till date. He submits that at this stage, petitioner would be satisfied, if the said legal notice is considered and decided by passing a speaking order in a time-bound frame.

3. Notice of motion.

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4. Mr. Saurabh Mohunta, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and has no objection to the innocuous prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.

6. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the present petition, respondents No.3 and 4/competent authority are directed to consider and decide the claim made by the petitioner in legal notice dated 22.04.2024 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

7. The petition stands disposed of.
