1. In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that petitioner is working as a part time Sweeper with the respondents since July, 1994 and has already rendered approximately 30 years of service but her services are not being regularized though the claim of the petitioner is squarely covered by the judgment of this Court in CWP No. 10238 of 2017 titled as *Jeewan Lata Vs. State of Punjab and others*, decided on 10.05.2019.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the legal notice dated 19.07.2024 (Annexure P-7) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.



3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Satnam Preet Singh, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the legal notice dated 19.07.2024 (Annexure P-7) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be duly conveyed to the petitioner.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

6. Ordered accordingly.
