1. Prayer in this writ petition is for quashing action of respondent Nos.1 and 2 of forcible recovery of petitioner's truck bearing registration No.PB-08-EB-9283 with the help of Recovery Agent.

2. Learned counsel for respondent – Bank, on instructions from Mr. Rajender Prasad, Manager (Legal), HDFC, submits that this writ petition is rendered infructuous as petitioner's account has been settled and closed.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that he does not have any instruction in this respect.

4. Be that as it may, in view of the categorical statement made by learned counsel for respondent -Bank, we find no ground for continuation of present proceedings.
